## **Ephesians 2:1-9**


You were dead because of your sins and offenses, which you committed in your allegiance both to the present age and to the ruler of the power of the air – that spirit who is even now at work among “the children of rebellion.” And all of us were among them; we lived at the level of the flesh, following every whim of the flesh, every fancy of this age, and so by nature deserved God’s wrath like the rest.

But God, rich in mercy and loving us so much, brought us to life in Christ, even when we were dead in our sins. It is through this grace that we have been saved. God raised us up and, in union with Christ Jesus, gave us a place in the heavenly realm, to display in ages to come how immense are the resources of God’s grace and kindness in Christ Jesus. And it is by grace that you have been saved, through faith – and even that is not of ourselves, but the gift of God. Nor is it a reward for anything that you have done, so nobody can claim the credit.
