How do our finances and possessions reveal where our heart is truly set?

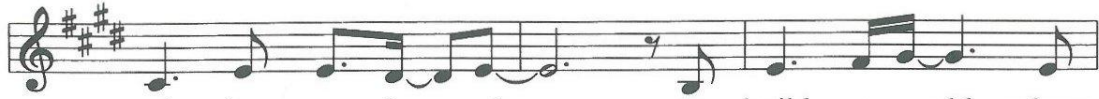
